

## Assessing Heritage Merit

There are 6 criteria that the Heritage Advisory Panel looks at when assessing the heritage merit of a building:

- ◆ ARCHITECTURAL/ LANDSCAPING
- ◆ HISTORY
- ◆ ENVIRONMENT
- ◆ USABILITY
- ◆ INTEGRITY
- ◆ VULNERABILITY

What is Heritage Designation?

Heritage designation is a method of conserving property. Section 11 of the Heritage Conservation Act gives municipal councils the power to designate land and/or buildings with the objective of retaining a heritage legacy for appreciation by present and future generations. The Community Heritage Steering Committee of the Municipality of Oak Bay was established to advise Council on all matters relating to heritage.

### RESTRICTIONS

Once designation of a property is approved by Council, that status, along with its restrictions, passes automatically to future owner(s) upon change of ownership. The *Heritage Conservation Act* of BC stipulates that, once designated, the building or structure cannot be demolished, the façade or exterior of a building may not be altered, and designated land cannot be built upon, without prior approval by resolution of Council.
