BYLAW NO. 3603

(**amended by Bylaws No. 3726, 3922 and 4062)

A Bylaw to require a licence for the carrying on of business and to fix and impose business licence fees

The Municipal Council of The Corporation of the District of Oak Bay, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. (1) In this Bylaw, the expressions used shall have the respective meanings assigned to them in the *Municipal Act*, except as specifically set forth in this Section or where the context otherwise requires.
- (2) In this Bylaw, except where the context otherwise requires,
 - (a) “AMUSEMENT MACHINE” means a mechanical, manual, electrical, computerized, automated or any other type of device used, operated or played for entertainment or amusement, and for which a coin or token must be inserted or a fee charged for the use of said device;
 - (b) “CORPORATION” means The Corporation of the District of Oak Bay;
 - (c) “COUNCIL” means the Municipal Council of the Corporation;
 - (d) “DIRECT SELLER” means every person personally selling or soliciting the sale of books, magazines or periodicals, whether of an educational nature or not, or selling any other goods, wares or merchandise, or contracts for repairs, renovations or any other service whatsoever, either on his own behalf or as an agent for another, from door to door within the Municipality;
 - (e) “INTERMUNICIPAL BUSINESS LICENCE” means a business licence which authorizes a business to be carried on within the boundaries of the Participating Municipalities, for the classes of businesses described in Schedule "C" to this Bylaw.

 - (f) “LICENCE INSPECTOR” means the person appointed by the Council to collect licence fees and to administer this Bylaw;
 - (g) “MUNICIPALITY” means the District Municipality of Oak Bay;
 - (h) “PARTICIPATING MUNICIPALITY” means the District of Oak Bay, the District of Central Saanich, the City of Colwood, the Township of Esquimalt, the District of Langford, the District of Metchosin, the District of North Saanich, the District of Saanich, the Town of Sidney, the City of Victoria, and the Town of View Royal, and any other municipality that becomes party to an agreement with the District of Oak Bay for the offering of intermunicipal business licences;

 - (i) “PERSON” includes a corporation, partnership or proprietorship;
 - (j) “SCHOOL HOLIDAY” means any day other than a Saturday or Sunday which is a holiday for schools in the Greater Victoria School District No. 61;

- (k) "VENDING MACHINE" means any coin-operated machine or device for the purpose of dispensing goods, wares, merchandise or service; but shall not include such machines or devices that may be operated by charitable organizations.
- (3) In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires, wording importing the singular number or masculine gender shall include the plural or feminine gender, and the converse shall also apply.
2. Every person owning or operating any business carried on within the Municipality shall hold a valid and subsisting business licence issued by the Licence Inspector or, for Intermunicipal Business Licences, by a Participating Municipality, and shall, in the case of a licence issued by the Corporation, pay in advance to the Corporation the annual licence fee for such class of business as set out in the Schedules appended to and forming a part of this Bylaw.

3. (1) Every person applying for a business licence shall complete the application forms supplied by the Licence Inspector for such purpose.
- (**Bylaw 4062, adopted Nov.22/99)
- (2) An application for the first time, or for a transfer of a business licence, shall be signed by the owner or operator of the business or his duly authorized agent, provided that in the case of partnerships or multiple owners, any one of such partners or owners may apply and such partner or owner shall be deemed to be duly authorized by all the partners or owners.

- (3) The application form shall be delivered to the Licence Inspector and, for applications for business licences other than those identified in Schedule "C" attached hereto, shall be accompanied by the fee prescribed by Schedule "B" for the class of business, as shown in Schedule "A", in respect of which the application is made, with the classification of the business to be determined by the Licence Inspector.

- (4) An application form delivered to the Licence Inspector for an Intermunicipal Business Licence shall be accompanied by a fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for the class of business, as shown in Schedule "C", in respect of which the application is made, with the classification of the business to be determined by the Licence Inspector.

- (5) Provided that there has been no change in any of the particulars of the business as noted on the original application form, and without derogating from the authority of Council to refuse a business licence under the *Municipal Act*, an application form is not required to renew a business licence.

4. (1) Subject to the criteria set out in Section 667 of the *Municipal Act*, the Licence Inspector is hereby empowered to grant, renew, transfer and suspend business licences. No person shall carry on a business for which a licence is required by this Bylaw during the period of suspension of such licence.

- (2) Business licences shall be issued for a one year period commencing on the first day of January and terminating on the thirty-first day of December in each and every year. The annual licence fee prescribed herein shall be reduced by one-half in respect of a business that becomes liable to be licensed after the thirty-first day of July in any year. No licence fee or part thereof shall be

refundable.

- (3) Before any business licence is issued, the Licence Inspector shall satisfy himself that, where applicable, the applicant has qualified in all respects under the *Apprenticeship Act*.
 - (4) Before any business licence is issued, the Licence Inspector shall satisfy himself that the carrying on of a business from the premises in respect of which the licence is sought will not violate the Zoning Bylaw of the Corporation.
 - (5) Before any business licence is issued, the Licence Inspector shall satisfy himself that all public authorities having jurisdiction over the carrying on of a particular class of business, or the carrying on of a business from particular premises, have approved all aspects of the application. Where requested by the Licence Inspector, the applicant shall submit letters or certificates of approval from the appropriate authorities.
 - (6) Every business licence issued pursuant to this Bylaw shall state that the holder is licensed to carry on the business stipulated therein in a lawful manner for the period specified at the premises stated.
 - (7) Every business licence issued pursuant to this Bylaw shall be deemed to be a personal licence to the licensee therein named, and, where applicable, shall be valid only for the premises therein named.
 - (8) Every person, before changing his place of business within the Municipality, shall obtain a transfer of his business licence.
5. (1) As a condition under which a business licence may be obtained, and subject to Section 658 of the *Municipal Act*, a person applying for a licence to carry on a resident business for the first time shall, in respect of a class of business designated in Schedule “A” as requiring a bond, give security to the Corporation in the form of cash in the amount of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).

- (2) The conditions under which the security given pursuant to this Section shall be required, held and returned shall be as set out in Section 656 of the *Municipal Act*.

6. (1) As a condition under which a business licence may be obtained, and subject to Section 658 of the *Municipal Act*, a person applying for a licence to carry on a non-resident business shall, in respect of a class of business designated in Schedule “A” as requiring a bond, give security to the Corporation in the form of cash in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

- (2) The conditions under which the security given pursuant to this Section shall be required, held and returned shall be as set out in Section 655 of the *Municipal Act*.

7. (1) In this section,
- (a) “BUSINESS PREMISES” means a premises on which a retail, amusement, recreation or other business is carried on, and shall include a recreation facility owned and operated by The Corporation of the District of Oak Bay; and
 - (b) “OPERATOR” shall include an owner, proprietor, lessee, or manager of a business premises or their employees.

- (2) The number of amusement machines in or ancillary to any business premises shall not exceed
 - (a) one per 1,000 square feet of space open to the public on the business premises; or
 - (b) three (3),whichever is less.
 - (3) For the purpose of calculating the number of amusement machines permitted under subsection (2) hereof, actual floor area measurements shall be
 - (a) rounded up to the nearest thousand if the amount by which the area exceeds the last complete 1,000 square feet, or zero, as the case may be, is 750 square feet or greater; and
 - (b) rounded down to the nearest thousand, or to zero, as the case may be, if the amount by which the area exceeds the last complete 1,000 square feet, or zero, as the case may be, is less than 750 square feet.
 - (4) No person being an operator of any business premises in which there are one or more amusement machines shall suffer or permit any person under the age of 16 years to use, operate or play any amusement machine on the business premises on any day, other than a Saturday, Sunday or school holiday, except between the hours of 3:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m., and an operator may demand two pieces of documented proof of age from any person on the business premises.
 - (5) Where reasonable doubt exists as to whether the age of a person on the business premises in which there are one or more amusement machines is 16 years or over, an operator of the business premises shall deny access to the amusement machine or machines to any person who is unable to provide documented proof of age, at all times when access is restricted under subsection (4) hereof.
 - (6) Every operator of any business premises in which there are one or more amusement machines shall post, in a conspicuous place at the entrance to the business premises and within three (3) feet of each amusement machine, the regulations contained in subsections (4) and (5) hereof.
 - (7) This section shall not apply to that portion of a business premises licensed under the *Liquor Control and Licensing Act*, from which, or during those times which, minors are excluded pursuant to the said *Act*; provided that when minors are permitted the licensed portion shall be treated as part and parcel of such business premises for the purposes of this Bylaw, and during such times any amusement machines in excess of the number that would be permitted for the entire business premises under subsection (2) hereof must be taken out of operation.
8. In the event of any person who is the holder of a business licence under this Bylaw making, during the currency of such licence, any change in the nature, character, kind or description of the business carried on by him within the Municipality, or engaging in any other further or additional business therein, it shall be the duty of such person forthwith to notify the Licence Inspector of such facts in writing, and thereupon to take out and pay for such other, further or additional licence as shall be applicable or required under the provisions of this Bylaw.
 9. The Licence Inspector or any Police Officer of the Corporation may, at all reasonable times, enter upon any property for the purpose of ascertaining whether the provisions of this Bylaw are being complied with.
 10. Every person required to be licensed under this Bylaw and every person in charge of a business requiring

a licence, shall, on demand of the Licence Inspector or any Police Officer of the Corporation, produce and show to the Inspector or any Police Officer of the Corporation, the licence he is required to hold, or give satisfactory proof that such a licence has been obtained; where the licence relates to any vehicle, the owner or driver of such vehicle shall at all times cause the licence to be carried on such vehicle.

11. Notwithstanding anything herein contained, the amount of any and every business licence fee payable by any person pursuant to the provisions of this Bylaw shall be a debt due by that person to the Corporation, which shall be recoverable together with any costs in any court of competent jurisdiction.
12. A person who contravenes this Bylaw by doing an act that it forbids, or by omitting to do an act that it requires to be done, commits an offence and is liable, upon summary conviction, to a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and not more than Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00), plus costs, and where the conviction is for carrying on a business for which a licence is required without holding a valid and subsisting licence for the business then the amount which should have been paid for the licence, where a licence may be issued, shall be added to the said fine and shall form part of the fine.
13. The following Bylaws are hereby repealed except insofar as they repeal any other bylaw:

PROVIDED that such repeals shall not affect any offence committed, or penalty or punishment incurred, under such repealed Bylaws, and any such penalty or punishment may be imposed as if this Bylaw had not been passed.

14. This Bylaw may be cited as the "***BUSINESS LICENCE BYLAW, 1988***".
