THIS IS A BI-WEEKLY CURBSIDE TOTE COLLECTION SERVICE
All recyclables and garbage must be at the curbside by 7:30 a.m. on the day of your pickup

Basic Entitlement: One (1) wheeled grey 140 litre regulation garbage container per collection day. One (1) blue regulation container: newspaper, mixed paper products, box board.

Blue Box: glass and tin cans, rigid plastic containers and packaging, lids, clean pizza boxes and corrugated cardboard may be bundled with string/twine and put alongside blue box.
Maximum bundle size: 90cm x 45cm x 20cm (36" x 18" x 8").

EXTRA ENTITLEMENT FOR GARBAGE

Two (2) additional containers (72 litres each) may be collected per collection day with appropriate number of garbage tickets attached.
1st can = 2 tickets 2nd can = 3 tickets (5 tickets in total)
These may be purchased at the Municipal Hall, Recreation Centre and Public Works office.

PROHIBITED MATERIALS

Dead animals, animal feces, rocks, hypodermic needles, liquids containing toxic compounds, diapers, grass, leaves or yard trimmings, building refuse, drywall, antifreeze, car batteries, corrugated cardboard, appliances, directories, tires, scrap metal and some electronics.
Damp or wet materials must be drained, wrapped and sealed.

DUMPING AT THE MUNICIPAL YARD - 1771 ELGIN ROAD

8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. weekdays (excluding holidays)
8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. noon on Saturdays (excluding holidays)
Residents with a valid decal affixed to their vehicle windshield may deposit into the appropriate bins:

- garbage securely fastened in plastic bags
- yard trimmings, grass, leaves, (branches must be less than 3 feet in length and 3 inches in diameter)
- leftover paint, and empty paint cans
- plastic containers and rigid plastic packaging, clean plastic shopping bags
- corrugated cardboard (must be flattened)
- mixed paper, newspaper, boxboard
- small metal items, except fridges and freezers
- propane tanks
- car batteries / household batteries
- fill dumps (minimum \$10 per load)

No wood or building materials. No furniture, mattresses or tires.

PLEASE BE PREPARED TO PROVIDE PROOF OF RESIDENCE IF REQUESTED.

LEAF COLLECTION SERVICE

Starting on or about October 22 residents may place leaves on the boulevard to be collected by Municipal forces. We ask that leaves not be placed in a location that will block street drains. **Note:** this program is for leaves only!

FREE GARDEN REFUSE COLLECTION March 19, 2012 - March 23, 2012

All garden refuse to a **maximum** volume of 3 cubic metres per property in total must be placed on the boulevard by 8:00 a.m. on the day of your pickup. Material must not exceed 5' in length and 3" in diameter. Material may be placed loose, **not** in plastic bags. No stumps, wood, rocks or soil.
Note: material may be placed on boulevard maximum 10 days prior to pickup.
